

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Each lesson starts with a "Trash to Treasure" takeaway based on a recycling theme. Here is our outline:

Begin each lesson by reading the 2911 Scripture and the definitions for each TRASH and TREASURE. Move to the TRASH and TREASURE reading section and answer the questions. GREEN LIVING will provide deeper insight into each lesson, and RECYCLED REIMAGINED will give takeaway actions. Finally, close with Salvage the SCRIPTURE and GIVE it BACK prayer.

While Project 2911 is not a secret code that God wants us to unlock, it is super cool that ALL the 2911 verses we will study point to the gifts God has generously given to us. He wants us to "recycle" these gifts, not in the typical recycle fashion that keeps going around and around, but to purposefully use them for God's glory. Look at the recycle reimagined symbol. Can you see the difference? The last recycle arrow is pointing UP. This is the new way to UPcycle! We are giving BACK our talents so God can be worshiped, praised, and glorified. He is the only One that gets the credit and our thanksgiving.

LESSON ONE

RECYCLE the EXAMPLE


"Thine, O LORD, is the GREATNESS, and the POWER and the GLORY, and the VICTORY and the MAJESTY; for ALL that is in the heaven and in the earth is Thine. Thine is the kingdom, O LORD, and Thou art exalted as head above all." 1 Chronicles 29:11 (KJ21)

"Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young. Set an EXAMPLE for the believers in what you say and in how you live. Also set an example in how you love and in what you believe. Show the believers how to be pure." 2 Timothy 4:12 (NIRV)

TRASH: GRASP

- A firm hold or grip. Clutch. **Snatch.**
- Hold with hand or claws strongly. Seize and hold firmly.

TRASH to TREASURE



In today's lesson, King David gives a ginormous assignment to his son, Solomon. The king is handing over the plans to build the FIRST temple in Jerusalem. Up to this point in Israel's history, there had never been a permanent place to worship God. The building plans for the temple were extremely detailed requiring materials of gold, silver, bronze, iron, wood, and precious stones. This temple construction was a BIG DEAL. The crazy part of the story is that Solomon was young and inexperienced (vs.1). How in the world was he going to pull this off? We will quickly find that he didn't. GOD DID! Have you ever been given a job SO BIG that you had NO IDEA how you were ever going to get it done? Solomon probably felt the same way. Let's read about the amazing POWER of God and the building of Solomon's temple in 1 Chronicles 28:20-21, 29:1-20.

1. Talk about a time when you had a job that seemed too big to complete.
2. 1 Chronicles 29:11 talks about the awesomeness of GOD. What belongs to God?
3. Look at the trash and treasure definitions. What are things you grasp? Why is it sometimes hard to GIVE away?
4. Read 2 Timothy 4:12 and identify 5 ways God calls us to be examples. Who has been an EXAMPLE in your life?
5. How can you be an EXAMPLE for others and GIVE BACK what GOD has so generously given to you?

GREEN LIVING BOOM!

King David set an **EXAMPLE** for Solomon, for his entire kingdom, and for us! Solomon saw that his dad was a man true to his word. David told Solomon to be strong and brave (even though he was young) and to do the work because God would be with him, help him, and never leave him (1 Chronicles 28:20-21). David also set an example for his kingdom by giving from the government treasury and from his personal treasury. Just like our Heavenly Father, King David gave above and beyond what was expected. Because of David's EXAMPLE of generous giving, the people responded with generous giving. King David led by example as he gave all the honor and glory to God. God is all powerful. Everything comes from Him and belongs to Him! God knows our heart's intention and desires us to live our lives by being **examples** for HIM!

TREASURE: GIVE

- Freely hand over to. To present voluntarily and without expecting anything in return. **Let go.**

RECYCLED REIMAGINED

God has called each of us to a BIG JOB! It might not be building a temple, but it is just as important. Scripture says:

"For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do." Ephesians 2:10 (NIV)

Just like Solomon, God has work that has been prepared for you. God has chosen you to lead by example by what you say, how you live, how you love, what you believe in, and being pure. Everything comes from Him and belongs to Him. Stop grasping onto the things of this world. Serve Him and **GIVE BACK!**

SALVAGE the SCRIPTURE

"God is able to do far more than we could ever ask for or imagine. He does everything by his power that is working in us. GIVE him glory in the church and in Christ Jesus. GIVE him glory through all time and for ever and ever. Amen." Ephesians 3:20-21 (NIRV)

GIVE it BACK

Lord, everything in heaven and on the earth belongs to You! Teach me to willingly let go of things I grasp. Help me to be an example for You and do the work You have set out for me. I know You will provide over and above what I could ever expect or imagine! Teach me to give You all the praise! Amen.
